

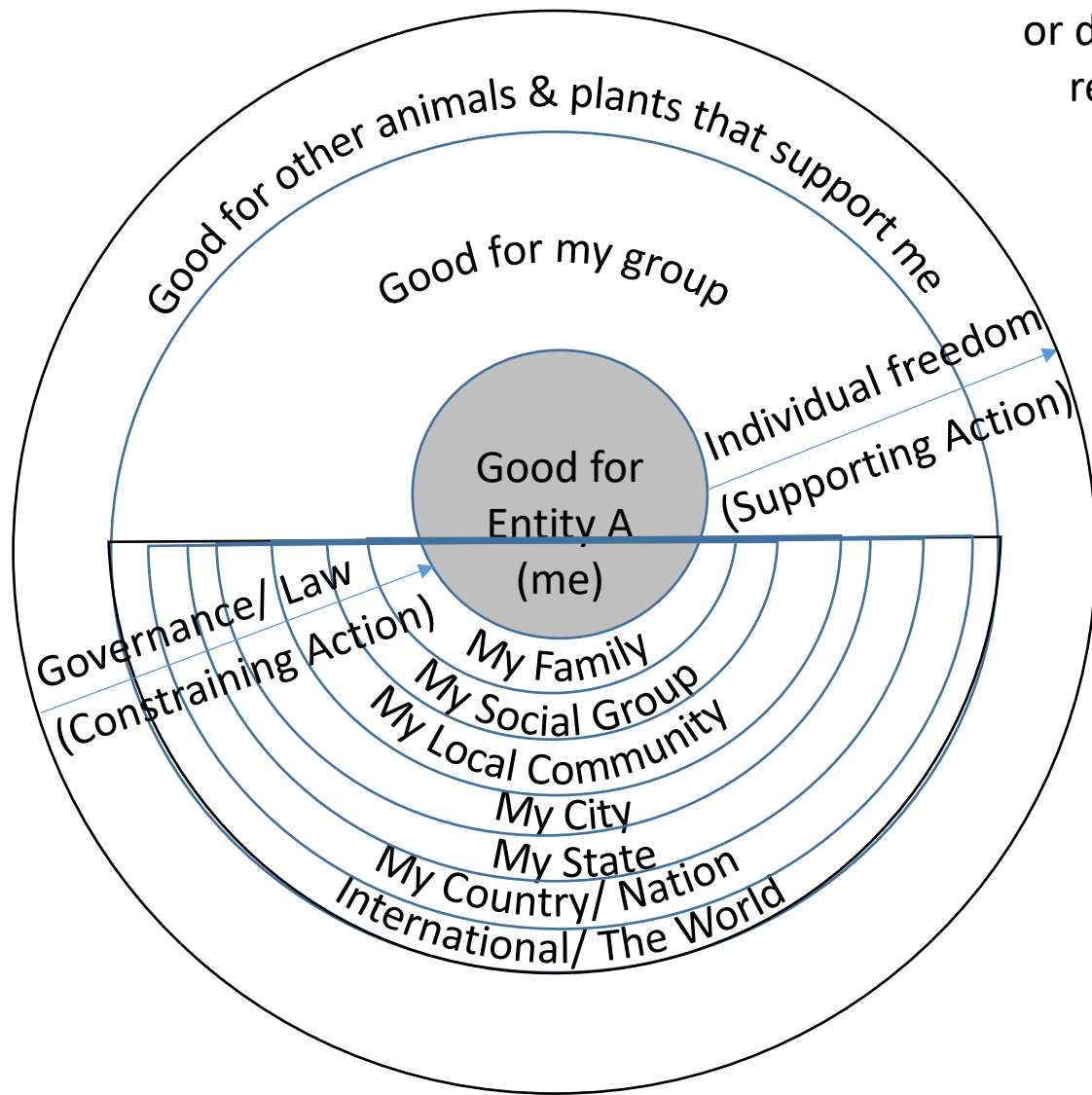
The Ethical Eye

required]

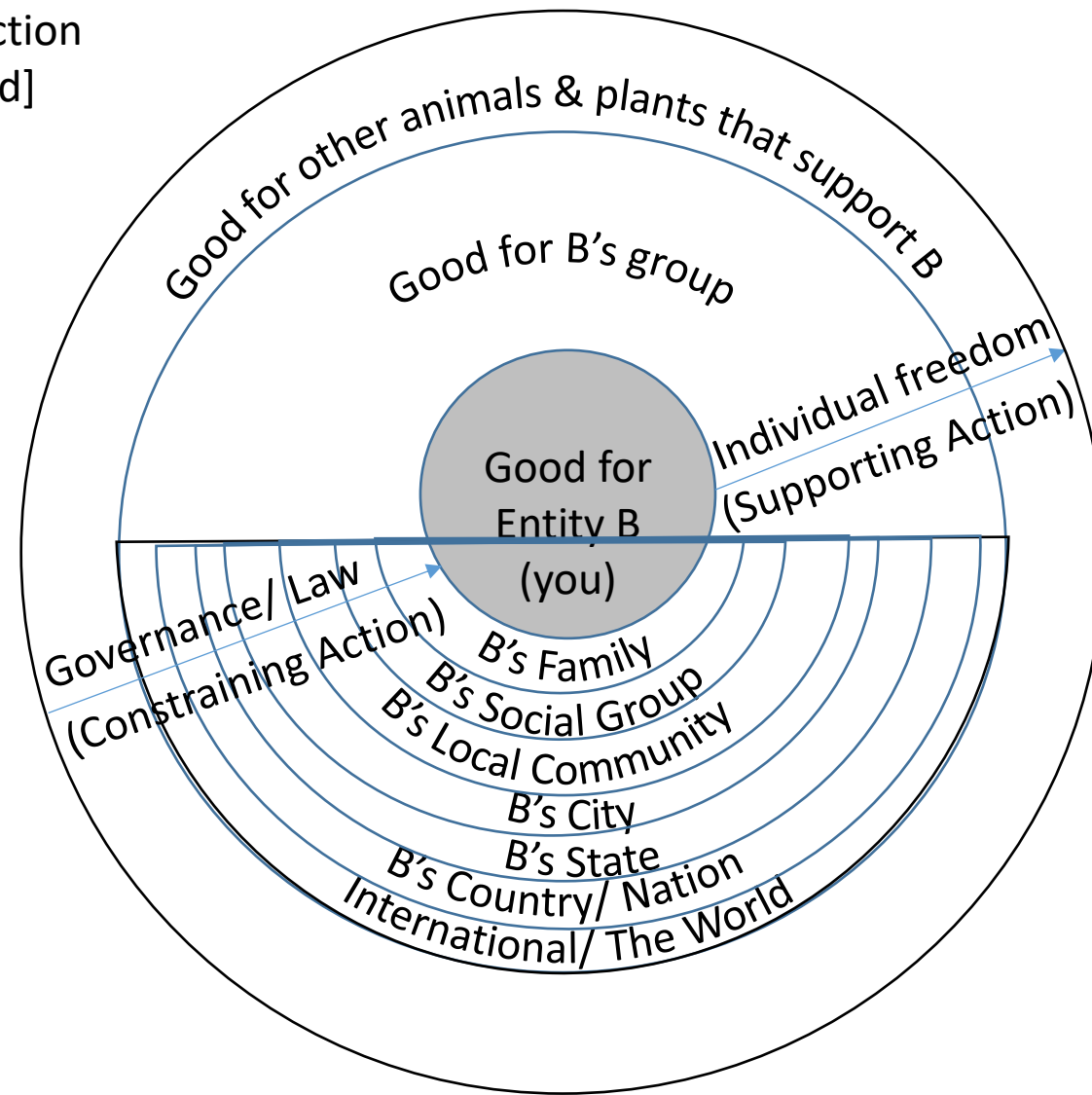
Cooperation

Notes:

1. Either competition or cooperation occurs wherever an issue crosses any individual or group line in the diagram.
2. The competition may be for food, money, objects, resources, affection, power, pride, prestige or glory.
3. The motivation may be survival, sex, comfort, convenience, happiness, betterment or greed.
4. The choice of action depends upon belief filters about 'true', 'right' and/ or 'good' . [What A thinks is true or right may not actually be so. Similarly what A or B thinks is good for A or B may or may not be, and something that is not good for A or B now may be so in the long term, and vice versa.]
5. The choice of action also depends upon perceptual filters such as current environment, state of mind/ upset, health issues or sleep deprivation.
